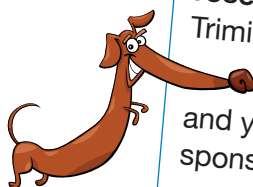

Nature Notes – Spring 2024

Mac Marshall

Two Bee eaters returned this year and I photographed them on 29th May but at the time of writing I haven't seen them for more than a week. Their appearance hasn't been widely circulated but the RSPB have been told.

I went to Sheringham Park where the rhododendrons were in full bloom although I am not a fan as, in my opinion, they are an invasive species which block out native plant life. There were newts in the pond in The Bower as usual.

In my small pond I have had no frogs breed this year, the first time in 17 years.

I went to Minsmere in early May and was lucky enough to see 4 bitterns in one day along with other species. We watched a stoat carrying its kits from one nest site to another. It was just like a cat with kittens. I also saw a pair of Marsh Harriers doing a food transfer. They fly together then the male with the food rises several feet above the female, releases the food and the female catches it in mid-air and returns to the nest to feed the young. It's spectacular.

On the Suffolk farm I was invited to watch their herd of cows being let out on to grass for the first time this year. They were 3 weeks late because the land was too soggy to allow them on it. As soon as they got on the grass they ran and jumped and ran again, with the large bull charging up and down, while some of the calves were a bit wary of the green stuff, they soon joined in.

It was a joy to see and even the farm dogs were just as excited. I'm going again next week.
