Friday 6th September, starting at 6:30pm

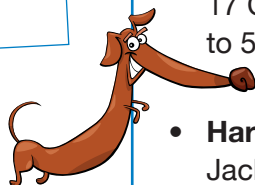

Nature Notes – Summer 2024

Mac Marshall

I had a change of scenery when I visited RSPB Old Moor near Barnsley. It is based on the site of a former colliery where my father in law worked pre Thatcher.

It was started by former miners and was so successful that it was taken over by the RSPB over 20 years ago and now can boast of breeding populations of bitterns, avocets and, this year, spoonbills. It also hosts sand martins, kingfishers, snipe and other waders. They encourage families and school parties and even have a dedicated Children's Hide.

Back home I recently went to Southrepps Common looking for butterflies as the Norfolk Wildlife Trust is doing a survey of certain species. I found about a dozen red admirals, 5 peacocks and a single small blue, which is what I was searching for. I also found 3 lizards on the boardwalk. I reported the sighting of the small blue.

From the cliff top I saw a baby seal and more than 40 cormorants sunning themselves on the groynes. When I got home I found a tick on my bare shin. It is now deceased.

Defibrillators

The village now has two defibrillators, one in the telephone box at the Church entrance and one at the Trimmingham Village Hall. These are both logged onto the Webnos and Circuit systems. Should you find yourself in the unfortunate position of requiring a defibrillator, call 999 and the Ambulance Service will have access to both and would let you know which is the closest and give you the code to open the box in which the equipment is housed.

It's also worth knowing you can easily check where defibrillators are by going onto the "defib finder" web site (or scan the QR code) and insert a post code to provide a location/map of all the machines in that area.
