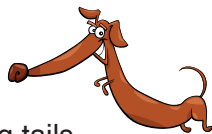

Parish council report from Liz

At the meeting in March there was much discussion about the proposed traffic calming measures attached the latest from NCC Highways dept.

PGA085 – Coast Road, Trimingham – Speed Limit Implementation

Norfolk County Council is proposing new speed limit measures to enhance road safety in Trimingham.

The plan includes introducing a 20mph speed limit in the village centre, encompassing Church Street, Loop Road, and a section of Church Road. Additionally, the proposal seeks to extend the current 30mph speed limit on the main routes leading into Trimingham, including Cromer Road, Mundesley Road, and Gimingham Road.

The improvements to traffic calming through the village were discussed, the council have been informed this work should take place before the autumn.

Nature Notes May 2025 *from Mac Marshall*

I sat in a hide at Minsmere one afternoon in March and watched bitterns for over an hour, for me, an exquisite experience. Other creatures I saw during the week were adders and red deer as well as the birds. They were all in full breeding plumage and included avocets, pintails, oystercatchers and my first sighting of returning sand martins.

On my friend's farm calving was in progress and they had 4 new-borns and were awaiting another 30. I was awakened every morning by the sound of woodpeckers rapping on dead branches or the calls of buzzards and red kites above.

Back home I walked round Southrepps Common and found a fair number of snake's head fritillaries (flowers not butterflies) more than I've seen before and including a white one rather than the usual purple speckled kind.

My Rosemary bush in full bloom and in the last few days I have seen several kinds of bee including honey bees and orange tip (both male and female), comma and red admiral butterflies.

Summer is on its way.
