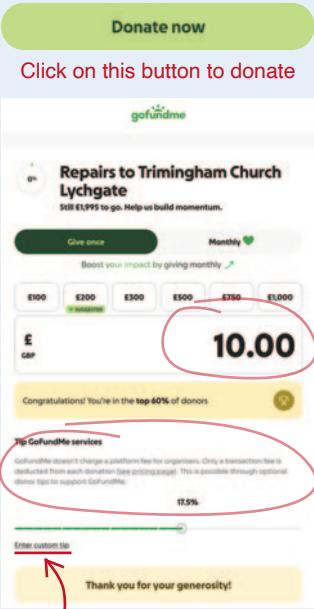

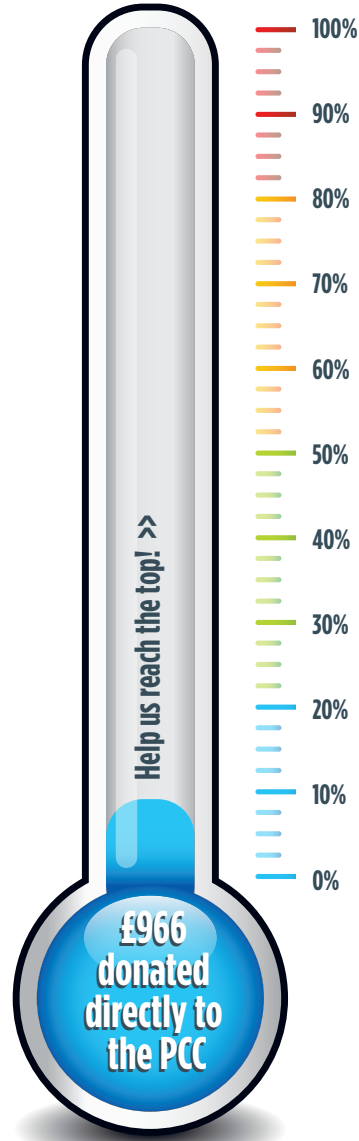

Improvements and clean up at Pilgrim Shelter

A few months ago, a village working party removed half of the double hedge along the Loop Road adjacent to the Pilgrim Shelter to allow the exposure of the full width of the road and therefore additional and safer parking. The majority of the old hedge roots have now been removed, with just one old tree stump left and this will be cleared in the near future. Many grateful thanks to Matthew Williams Digger Hire and driver Mark for all the hard work.



You will also have noticed that the tree has been well pollard near the Shelter. This had to be done because the telephone wires were running through it and had caused problems with the internet connection in the Shelter. All the relevant permissions were obtained for this work to be done and has not only done away with the problem of the wires getting rubbed but also let in a lot more light.



On the subject of gardening, you will also notice that the area around the Deep History Coast installation has also been cleared.

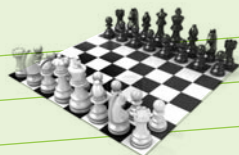

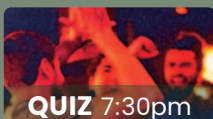

Nature Notes *from Mac Marshall*

I went to Suffolk again, this time to celebrate my friend Richard's 90th birthday with his family and other friends. Minsmere was a bit quiet apart from several Hobbies (a hunting bird) catching dragonflies and I got good views of the rare bearded tits.

On Dunwich Heath I watched Ant Lion larvae catching ants and other insects in their idiosyncratic way. The weather was a bit overcast so there were not so many butterflies around. There were swifts, swallows and sand martins hunting over the reed beds.

Back home the 5 robin chicks fledged but i still have a pair of robins in the garden so there is possibly another nest nearby. The blue tits have now stopped using their nest box. I think they raised 2 sets of chicks.

At Cley there were 4 cattle egrets along with avocets and swallows were feeding young inside the hides dodging the watchers to get to the nests on the rafters. I saw jack pike in the lake at Fellbrigg, shiny blue and 6 inches long, also newts in the pond in the walled garden, very visible in the clear water. I also watched a nuthatch tapping on an oak branch searching for insects.
